The **National Telecommunications Agency** or **Anatel** is a special agency in Brazil created by the general telecommunications act (Law 9472, 16/07/1997) in 1997 and governed by Decree 2338 of 07/10/1997. From the Ministry of Communications, Anatel has inherited the powers of granting, regulating and supervising telecommunications in Brazil as well as much technical expertise and other material assets.

## Description

RUT850 (RUT8507\*\*\*\*\* version) is using an Anatel approved LTE module.

IBRACE, using the powers invested by the Designation Act n° 19.436, of September 28th 2001, from ANATEL, granted Certification for Teltonika routers' LTE Cat4 modules, based on tests of type performed according to applicable technical standards and documentation sent by the manufacturer.
