If you're having trouble finding this page or some of the parameters described here on your device's WebUI, you should **turn on "Advanced WebUI" mode**. You can do that by clicking the "Advanced" button, located at the top of the WebUI.



## Services

The **Services** list displays the status of most of the device's services.



### Additional notes:

- The figure above is only an example. The actual ordering of the services on your devices will differ.

- The rightmost column contains a 'Change Settings' button next to each service. If you click on of these buttons, you will be redirected to the respective service's configuration window.
